SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

## 1 SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PARTICIPATION IN 8(A) PROGRAM.

2	(a) In General.—A covered small business concern
3	may, subject to the regulations issued by the Adminis-
4	trator of the Small Business Administration under sub-
5	section (b), elect to extend the period in which such cov-
6	ered small business concern participates in the program
7	established under section 8(a) of such Act (15 U.S.C.
8	637(a)) by one year.
9	(b) Emergency Rulemaking Authority.—Not
