
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the LA73-LA429 Intersection Improvement project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Ascension Parish Government located at 615 E Worthey St, Gonzales, Louisiana 70737. The funding would be used for mitigating traffic at an existing signalized intersection, utilized by residential, commercial, and industrial traffic amidst a historically disadvantaged area. The project will also upgrade some alternative transportation infrastructure, including converting sidewalks into shared use paths. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the project is authorized under Section 133(b) of title 23, United States Code and it will improve traffic flow and safety at the existing intersection.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133(b) (Surface Transportation Block Grant Program).
