
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

The funding would be used to provide services for child victims or witnesses of sexual/physical abuse, domestic violence, homicide, and human trafficking. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the program provides an essential public service by administering trauma-informed forensic interviews and medical evaluations for child victims of abuse and witnesses to violence to aid in investigations conducted by law enforcement, child protection, and prosecution.
