
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the LA47 Hayne Blvd Improvements project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the New Orleans Regional Planning Commission located at 10 Veterans Blvd, New Orleans, Louisiana 70124. The funding would be used for a "complete street" and traffic calming effort to enhance non-motorized, multimodal access to area residents. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will enhance safety by implementing traffic calming measures designed to slow traffic that has been documented to be at extremely high and unsafe speeds.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133(b) (Surface Transportation Block Grant Program).
