I am requesting funding for the King Avenue Road Rehabilitation Phase 3 in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Lutcher, located at 2500 Louisiana Avenue, Lutcher, LA 70071. The funding would be used to complete Phase 3 of the King Avenue Road Rehab which will finish the raising and replacement of the deteriorated asphalt roadway with a new concrete roadway. Phases 1 and 2 of the King Avenue Road Rehab were funded through federal funds. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will The project would be a valuable use of federal funds because it will create better traffic flow and mitigate future flooding of King Avenue, which serves as the town's main thoroughfare and evacuation route.
