I am requesting funding for the King Avenue Drainage Improvements project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Town of Lutcher, located at 2500 Louisiana Avenue, Lutcher, LA 70071. The funding would be used for removing and replacing +/-2,000 linear feet of erainage culvert within the King Avenue right-of-way to improve drainage conveyance from the Mississippi River Levee to Highway 3125 in the Town of Lutcher. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because improves stormwater conveyance from the Mississippi River Levee to Highway 3125, a major evacuation route in the Town of Lutcher.
